Independent Auditor's report on the statement of cash receipts and disbursements

To the Board Members of Transparency Maldives, the Republic of Maldives

1 We have audited the accompanying statement of cash receipts and disbursements ("the statement") of the Transparency Maldives, a Not-Profit Organization, for the year ended 31 December 2011. This statement is the responsibility of the management of the Transparency Maldives. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the accompanying statement based on our audit.

Management's responsibility for the financial statements

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of this statement in accordance with the cash receipts and disbursements basis as described in Note 3. This responsibility includes: designing, implementing and maintaining internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error; selecting and applying appropriate accounting policies; and making accounting estimates that are reasonable in the circumstances.

Auditor's responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the accompanying statement based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with International Standards of Auditing. International Standards on Auditing require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statement is free of material misstatement.

Notes to the statement of receipts and disbursements

1 Reporting entity

This statement of receipts and disbursements relates to Transparency Maldives, which is a non-profit organization that promotes collaboration, awareness, and other initiatives to improve governance and eliminate corruption from the daily lives of people. Transparency Maldives is the National Contact of Transparency International (TI) in the Maldives. It aims to be a constructive force in the Maldives by working with all sectors, including government, media, business, and other NGOs.

TM received formal registration from the Ministry of Home Affairs on 19 July 2007.

2 Summary of significant accounting policies

3 Basis for preparation

(a) Receipts

The statement of receipts and disbursements is prepared on the basis of cash receipts and disbursements. Receipts are accounted in the period in which such receipts are received.

(b) Disbursement


Disbursements are accounted in the period in which such disbursements are made.
